- How have you seen female bullying evolve over time in both a positive and negative way?

- What are some beautiful and powerful words and thoughts that represent women and our relationships with one another?
- What action steps can you personally take to promote kindness and encourage inclusivity within your school hallways and community?
- What action steps can our faculty and community take to create kinder, more supportive and inclusive school hallways and help bring an end to bullying?
- If there is an incident on campus, do you know who to report it to or who to go to for support?
- Do you feel like there is a support system in place at school to rely on when bullying takes place? If so, what could we improve upon to make that system even more helpful? If not, what could that support system look like to be the most helpful for our student body?
