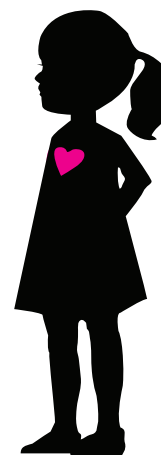
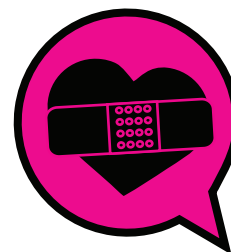


DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How have you seen bullying change in both a positive and negative way?

- What are some beautiful and powerful words and thoughts that represent our friendships with one another?
- What action steps can you personally take to spread kindness and include others within your school hallways and community?
- What action steps can our faculty and community take to create kinder, more supportive and inclusive school hallways and help bring an end to bullying?
- If something hurtful happens, do you know who to go to at our school to report it and to find support?
- Do you feel like there is a support system in place at school to rely on when bullying takes place?
- If so, what could we improve upon to make that system even more helpful? If not, what could that support system look like to be the most helpful for our student body?
