
Using the Spread Transactions Tool




• Please note: We recommend creating a new meal item if you will be using this tool. Also, if you will be allowing seconds, a separate "Second Meal" button will need to be used to track the "seconds" purchases.


Step 1: Enable seconds. This setting is found on the LCS1000>Lines>Line Settings>Prevent Seconds>No.



Step 2: Enter the transactions in the serving line.









Step 3: Close and process your line(s).


Step 4: Search for the transactions you processed in the LCS1000>Student tab>Batch Edit>Transaction Batches.




Step 5: Under Actions, select Spread Transactions.




Step 6: Select Entire Filter List.




Step 7: Select the number of days to spread the transactions over. For example, if you want to spread these transactions over the next 5 days, you would enter "5".



Step 8: Click the "Run" button.





Transactions are now evenly spread over the next 5 weekdays
